ELIGIBILITY

The Kern County Cattlemen's Association (KCCA) is offering two categories of scholarships:

- **Scholarship #1-** Available to graduates of any Kern County high school who are going to major in a field that is connected to the beef industry.
- **Scholarship #2-** Available for a child or grandchild of a current member of the Kern County Cattlemen's Association, regardless of major.

REQUIREMENTS

- Application must be typed or neatly handwritten.
- Essay must be typed.
- Two sealed letters of recommendation.
- Official transcripts from either high school or college (whichever you are currently attending).

Application, essay, and all supporting documentation must be postmarked by **March 15, 2025,** and mailed to:

- 4. Neatness and thoroughness of application



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
